NOTIFICATION

Allotment process for 6 months Ultra-Sound Course under PCPNDT Act

In compliance to order dated 10.09.2020 passed by Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court Jaipur Bench in SBCWP no. 5227/2020 and subject to the final decision of DB appeal filed by the State Government, the Directorate of Medical Education prescribed eligibility criteria for admission in 6 months Ultra-Sound Course under PCPNDT Act.

Eligibility (NEET PG 2020 qualified candidates)

1. Rajasthan domicile candidates having valid Rajasthan domicile certificate or
2. All in-service medical doctors serving in Government of Rajasthan

Note: NEET qualified and Rajasthan State NEET PG 2020 registered candidates who have opted for the PCPNDT course as 'Yes' and are not pursuing studies in PG Medical course will also be eligible for admission for current academic year.

As per provisions PCPNDT Rules 2014 and as per directions issued by Govt. of Rajasthan, the admission process for 6 months Ultra-Sound Course under PCPNDT Act will be carried out as below:

All the allotments shall be subject to the final decision of DB appeal filed by the State Government.
